



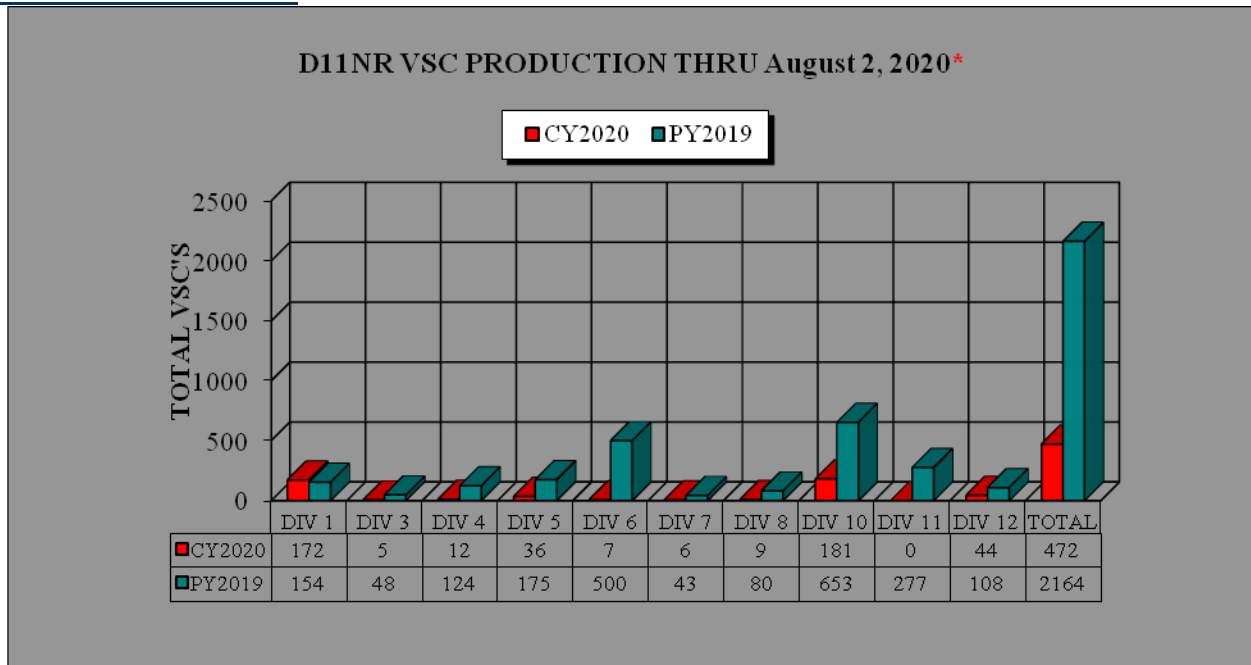

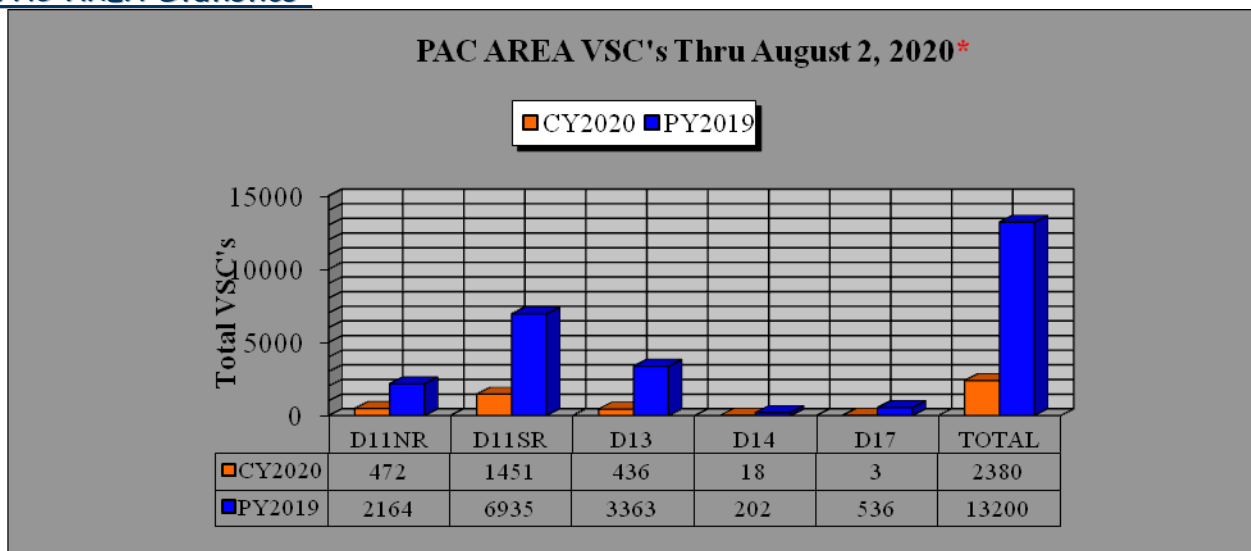

The 2020 goal for D11NR is 5,500 VSC's, a 10% increase over 2019. We are 7% of our goal for 2020 year and 30% of 2019 production at this time. The data source is AUXINFO*. Additional stats from AUXINFO* indicates that 418 or 89% have passed the VSC, 132 or 28% are First Time VSC's, and 167 or 35% are High Risk VSC's. In addition 45 Paddlecraft VSC's have been performed, which is approximately 9% of our total VSC production. We currently have 170 ACTIVE Vessel Examiners (VE's)*

*Current statistics shown in AUXINFO are thru March 30, 2020 which is frozen with AUXDATA II integration. Jan and I are working to create a similar report in AUXDATA II.

- **Recently the National V-Dept** released guidance on how to conduct the new Virtual VSC. Please review the document under "HOTLINE MESSAGES" on your D11NR website: <http://rbsafety.d11nuscgaux.info/ve/ve.html>

Important facts to note:

- 1-This is **NOT** an official VSC, it is **ONLY** for educational/informational purposes, therefore there will **NOT** be any official records or reporting.
- 2-This requires at least 2 mobile communication devices equipped with cameras; to facilitate visual verification of safety equipment and standard safety items per vessel examination criteria. You are **NOT** to be on site!
- 3-The virtual inspection is **NOT** an official examination, therefore the official 7012 and 7012a will **NOT** be used. **No** VSC Decals will be awarded. This is a one-on-one educational exchange and an information and equipment confirmation only.

6-Your time will be recorded on the **7029 Form; Section 99 B. DO NOT** record any time/numbers on the 7038 form nor submit thru the I.S.

7-Provided the owner agrees, you may save the owner contact information for a future VSC and decal award.

-NEW-VSC's ON RENTALS-At the request of Commodore Kirkwood, and after 18-years, the VSC Rental Program has been updated for 2019 and moving forward.

ANYONE who performs rental VSC's on PWC's, fishing boats, houseboats, paddlecraft, etc. **MUST** be aware of the new changes in effect after 1 June 2019.
